On Easter Sunday 40 archers from across the South West took part in the Bath Spring Albion, the first regional tournament of the year to be staged at the Batheaston ground.

All bow-types were represented, and competition was stiff, with Bath's Stuart Ohren emerging as victor in the Men's Recurve section, and Andy Carr in the Men's Barebow section.

Other trophy winners and top scorers included Jill Newland and Kay Smith from Archery GB and Judy Krasker from Deer Park Archers in the Women's Recurve, Compound and Longbow sections respectively, Dave Matthews from Cheltenham Archers in the Men's Compound section and Kevin Macey from Deer Park in the Men's Longbow category.

Steve Walker, tournament organiser, said: "We had a great day and we were blessed with good weather.

"It was great to get shooting again after all the rain which has waterlogged the ground on a few occasions. The Albion's a fairly tough shoot, with 3 dozen arrows at each of 3 distances - 80yds, 60yds and 50yds. But there were some great scores. There are some skilful archers in the South West region, and in our club!"
