YOU MUST READ AND COMPLY WITH THIS NOTICE

Bath Archers

Coronavirus 19 - Risk Control Measures

These measures, consistent with Archery GB advice, apply to all Phase 2 restricted shooting at Batheaston and Hunstrete (where applicable) until further notice. **Members must comply with these measures.** They are for your safety, and the safety of fellow archers, to minimise the risk of contracting Coronavirus 19 (COVID19). They do not ensure complete protection from the virus so **you should consider your own health risks when deciding whether to come and shoot**. Bath Archers will immediately suspend shooting if these measures are not observed by members attending Batheaston and Hunstrete ranges.

BEFORE ARRIVAL

- If you have symptoms of COVID-19 **DO NOT** come to the club.
- If you've had symptoms of COVID-19 **DO NOT** come to the club until 14 days after you have fully recovered.
- If a member of your family/group living at the same address is symptomatic **DO NOT** come to the club until at least 14 days after they have recovered.

• **Book one of ten available Batheaston targets** with an e-mail having checked availability on the interim Google Spreadsheet at the link below. He will take bookings in the date/time order in which the first ten requests are made.

• Targets may be used by two archers from different households, when shooting outdoors, in two single details (as long as 2m social distancing is maintained); one archer; or one group of archers of any size if from the same household.

- Do not turn up to the Batheaston range unless your name appears in the booking sheet.
- Bring your own refreshments but do not share them with anyone from another household.
- Bring your own whistle, pen and, if required, a clip board.

ON ARRIVAL

- Park your car 3m apart to avoid any physical contact.
- Stay at least 2m from one another at all times.
- Do not shake hands or other make any other physical contact.

• Clean your hands with antibacterial gel after you touch any surfaces which might be contaminated.

AT THE CLUBHOUSE

- The kitchen area will be closed off and is not to be used.
- No loitering or congregating in the clubhouse.
- Maintain the 2m rule at all times and observe the one-way route:
 - Setting up Access via front door/exit via side door.
 - Taking down- Access via side door/exit via front door.
- Wear gloves when moving targets (disposable gloves are available in the clubhouse).
- Dispose of used gloves in the rubbish bin or take them home.
- Toilets should only be used in emergencies and must be disinfected after each use.

WHILE SETTING UP

- If more than one archer is shooting, a Field Captain must be appointed (**No Field Captain No Shooting**).
- All targets must be positioned at least 4m apart centre to centre.
- Use gloves when moving targets.
- Clean your hands with the antibacterial gel provided after replacing faces.
- Only two archers per target (as long as 2m social distancing is maintained), unless you live at the same address with the other archer(s) on the target.

WHILE SHOOTING

- Do not pull or retrieve the arrows of other archers.
- Do not help find others lost arrows.
- Use gloves when moving targets.

WHILE TAKING DOWN

- Target faces to be left on the bosses.
- Use gloves when moving targets.

ON LEAVING

• Leave the clubhouse, toilets and ground secure and in good order.

• Paper scoresheets do not require a counter signature and can be emailed to records@batharchers.org. (Any scoresheets left in the clubhouse may not be actioned for several weeks).

• Any low value materiel left behind will be disposed of. High value equipment may be set aside in the clubhouse.
